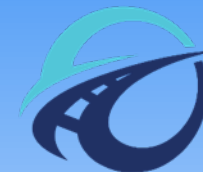

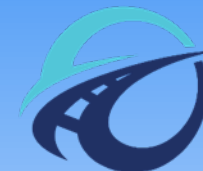

# REVIEW

## CITIZENS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

- ▶ Purpose: To **inform** the public and to **ensure** that the Transportation Measure (Measure) funding program revenues and expenditures are spent as promised to the public.
- ▶ Created to provide an increased level of accountability for the allocation of Measure T revenues to ensure the program is functioning as promised
- ▶ Comprised of seven (7) members – five (5) represent each of the County's supervisorial districts and two (2) "at-large" members



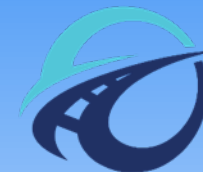

# REVIEW

## CITIZENS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

- ▶ Receive, **review**, inspect, and **recommend action** on independent financial and performance audits related to the Measure as well as other reports, studies, and plans from responsible agencies.
- ▶ **Review and comment** upon Measure expenditures to ensure that they are consistent with the Investment Plan.
- ▶ Present Committee recommendations, findings, and requests to the public and the Authority in a **formal annual report**

Received \$170,964,591 in sales tax revenue from April 2007 thru May 2024 (Projection is \$219M by March 2027)

FY 2022-23 receipts - \$16,263,082 (increase of \$539,434 from prior year)  
• Local Agencies received \$8,334,829

Have leveraged approximately \$320,743,900
